As indicated in our previous correspondence, Dr. Adam Lavallee will be the Associate Vice President (Next Generation) responsible for your school and your main liaison at MSA-CESS. We have entered your school in the database of the Middle States Association, and you will receive an invoice for your membership dues shortly.

Your proposed accreditation timeline is as follows:

This timeline has been recommended by the Visitor to your school, but we encourage you to dialogue with your MSA Accreditation Liaison regarding the best timeline for your school.

One condition of membership in the Middle States Association is nominating faculty and administrators who are willing and available to serve on visiting teams. At least one person from your school will serve annually (and we welcome more than one nominee). As you may know, accreditation involves a self-regulated peer review process. This service requires cadres of professionals from our member schools to volunteer their time and expertise. Nominees can be chosen from all grade levels and academic disciplines. All nominees should be prepared to serve at a time when they have no conflicting personal or professional obligations for the multi-night stay.
